Fest '93 Declared Success

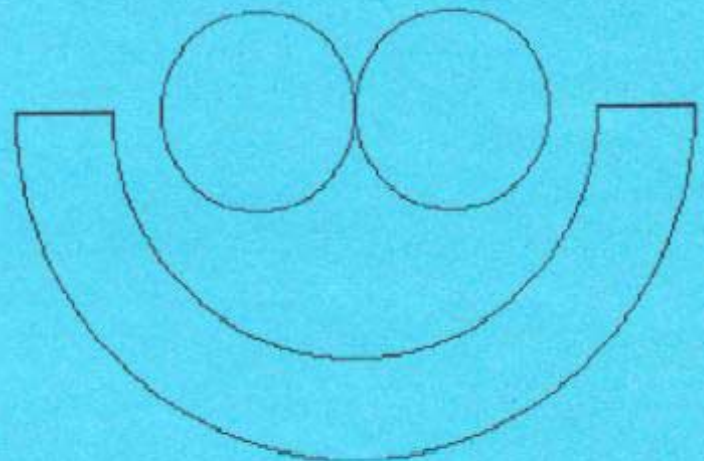
